Effective July 28, 2022, the amount that the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation pays for the Bioptic Driving Exams will increase to a total of \$250. Authorizations for Bioptic Driving Vision Exams will need to be done in two parts. The first part is the low vision exam portion. To authorize for this portion, go to the visual fee schedule and choose fee item 003. The second portion will be for the visual field testing. To authorize for this portion, choose Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) code 92083 amended to the amount of \$50.
