ORDER OF SELECTION

Combined Agency DRAFT Priority Categories

- Category 1: Eligible individuals who have the most significant disabilities and require a minimum of two services one of which meets an expanded definition.
- Category 2: Eligible individuals with significant disabilities who have limitations in two (2) major areas of functional capacities and require a minimum of two services one of which meets an expanded definition
- Category 3: Eligible individuals with significant disabilities who have limitations in one (1) major area of functional capacities and require a minimum of two services one of which meets an expanded definition
- Category 4: Consumers with a non-significant disability without functional limitations or who do not require two or more services.

Should funds become available, the Office may re-open services to closed priority categories. Kentucky Office of Vocational Rehabilitation will first serve those individuals on the waitlist on a first-applied, first-served basis, as established by the date of application. In cases where more than one priority category is opened, preference will be given to the higher priority category group based on significance of disability.
