What We Offer

- **Counseling and support services** to maximize your independence and understanding of what you can accomplish despite vision loss. We provide the tools, skills, and support to help you pursue education, job training and employment.
- Residential, day, and/or virtual classes through the McDowell Center in Louisville designed to teach you specific skills for daily life and career including Braille, technology, independent living, job readiness, travel with a white cane, and related programs and support services.
- In-home services to teach you how to use phones, tablets and computers, meal preparation, housekeeping, access print information, and other important life tasks without relying on vision.
- **Orientation & Mobility** evaluations and training with Certified O&M Specialists to teach you a variety of skills, including how to use a white cane, to help you get around safely and confidently.
- Bioptic driving assessment and training for eligible/qualified candidates.
