- CareerScope, a fully virtual evaluation that can be completed from home or your local career center.

Other Services

The Perkins Center offers additional services for its students, including:

Cafeteria Services

Students are provided 3 meals each day and an evening snack, 7 days per week.

Case Management

Each student is assigned a Case Manager who ensures they are receiving services and that progress is being made toward goals.

Transportation

Transportation staff coordinate dates, times, and locations of student pickup/drop-off when traveling to and from the Center for services.

Recreation Services

Recreation services provide students with daily structured and free activities designed to develop and maintain physical stamina, social skills, and leisure time structuring.

Residential and Assisted Living Housing

Housing is provided to students who choose to live at the Center while completing their training. Staff supervise and monitor them while encouraging independent living, providing adjustment services, and enhancing social skills.
