Vending

Our vending machine options range from small snack machines to refrigerated and frozen machines. Our vendors and KBE team will ensure a wide variety of products, functional machines, and well-stocked dated products.

Micro Markets

Micro Markets are an unmanned convenience store concept. These self checkouts offer a wide variety of products that can include frozen meals, coffee machines, and microwaveable items. Our vendors and the KBE team will assist in teaching how to use the kiosks and ensure a clean and well-stocked market.

Food Service and Hybrids

Food service can be a small concession stands, coffee bars, full-service cafeterias, and even a hybrid of a micro market and a cafeteria. KBE is also the food service provider for the U.S. Army at Ft. Knox and Ft. Campbell. Our vendors and KBE team will provide hot and cold meals. This typically includes a daily special developed by the vendor and their kitchen staff.
