Welcome, Introductions and Agenda Review:

KYVOR Administrator, Nanci Howard welcomed everyone to the meeting and held a brief introduction for KYOVR Administrative Specialist, Pepper Caudill, before turning the meeting over to Chair, Amanda Owen.

Chair Report:

Chair, Amanda Owen began meeting by sharing her screen and explaining the Google Drive, Brainstorming Doc for the Advocacy & Education Committee. This doc reiterated the committee's previous ideas to 1) introduce a Power Point that can be used by professionals at conferences, trainings, etc. to educate; and 2) Create an APP that can be utilized in Kentucky as a single point of access to information of resources, education, advocacy and embracing mindset of opportunities for parents/educators/workforce.

Subcommittee Discussion:

Member, Diana Merzweiler began discussing IEP requirements and how that pertains to the Committee's "Road Map to Employment" section of the Google doc. Chair, Amanda Owen added this verbiage to the Google doc that she was still screen sharing. Amanda went on to provide personal, historical background of her experience as an educational provider. She explained how the IEP will

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work in conjunction with the “Portfolio” that this Committee wants to collaborate with the Department of Education to incorporate into the school systems. There was further discussion between Diana and Amanda concerning this matter and Amanda was updating the Google doc with verbiage as the discussion went on.

Administrator, Nanci Howard made mention that the February 2023 minutes needed to be approved and **David Allgood made the motion to approve the February 2023 minutes and Amanda Friend provided a second to the motion. The motion passed unanimously.**

Chair, Amanda Owen began discussions of the “What is Employment First?” section of the google doc and added verbiage to the doc as discussion was held.
