Pre-Employment Transition Services

Do you know that as early as age 14 students with a disability can...

- Explore careers?
- Get work experience?
- Learn about college and training programs?
- Learn how to be a good employee?
- Learn how to speak up, make good decisions about their life, and find support in their journey?

The KY Office of Vocational Rehabilitation (OVR) provides Pre-Employment Transition Services and Transition services to students with IEPs, 504 plans, or other documentation of disabilities.

What are Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS)?

Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS) are the earliest set of services for students with disabilities to explore careers and gain experience in work related activities. Students who are eligible, as well as students who are considered potentially eligible for Vocational Rehabilitation services may receive Pre-ETS. However, potentially eligible students may only receive Pre-ETS. Eligible students may receive Pre-ETS and additional services that are required to participate in Pre-ETS or attain their career goal. There are providers across the state that are available to come into schools to provide these services.

Potentially Eligible Students may only receive the following Pre-ETS...

- Job exploration counseling
- Work based learning experiences.
- Post-secondary opportunities
- Work readiness training
- Self-advocacy instruction

Eligible Students may receive Pre-ETS and transition services, including...

- Tuition Assistance
- Transportation
- Assistive Technology
- Other services to help achieve employment goal

How can students access Pre-Employment Transition Services?

A Pre-ETS Referral form and documentation of a student's disability with student's and parent's signature (if student is under age 18 or have a court appointed guardian) must be completed and sent to a Pre-ETS Coordinator or Counselor with the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation.
