Practical Nurses

Licensure Examination

The vendor is Pearson-Vue (National Council Licensure Examination).

The Office of Vocational Rehabilitation consumer should complete the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) Application and give to the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation counselor. The counselor then should request that the consumer Pro Card at Central Office be used to register the consumer online for the test.



After registration is complete, the counselor will issue a costing-back authorization at the direction of the consumer Pro Card holder to charge the cost of this testing to the consumer's case.

The charge for this examination is \$200.00.

Licenses

Vendor is Kentucky Board of Nursing (KBN); and the payment is made by means of an Inter-Agency Authorization.

The Office of Vocational Rehabilitation counselor issues an interagency authorization and mails or delivers the authorization to the Kentucky Board of Nursing along with a completed application completed by the consumer. The authorization will serve in lieu of a check and the Kentucky Board of Nursing will bill the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation through the eMARS interagency billing system.

Either the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation or the school may assume responsibility for mailing the state board application to the Kentucky Board of Nursing. If the school mails it, they should attach a letter to the completed application indicating that Office of Vocational Rehabilitation will accept interagency billing for the fee.

Examination	\$125
Administration (Retake)	\$125
Endorsement (Nurse coming from out of state)	\$165
Reinstatement (For a Kentucky resident who has lost their nursing license and is trying to get it back or dropped license due to financial problems and is trying to get it back.)	\$135
Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioner Registration	\$165
Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioner Reinstatement	\$135
